The Miss Standing Rock Pageant will be held on Thursday, August 22, 2024 @ 1:00 pm at the Kenel District building.


The <u>Deadline</u> for the application is <u>August 16, 2024</u> at 4:30 pm.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

There is no limit to the number of entries from any district. The pageant officially begins after the luncheon and all contestants must be present to pre-register by that time.

There will be a panel of (4) judges for the pageant. Selections of the Miss Standing Rock 2024 will be based on appearance, poise, Indian characteristics, scholastic interest and dedication to the advancement of the Indian people of Standing Rock. Selections of the Miss Standing Rock 2024 will be based on the qualifications stated in the criteria. The judge's decision will be final. The coordinators are not judges for the contest; they are only there as designated representatives for the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe and pageant.

Contestants (other than the winners) who have previously entered the contest are cordially invited to enter again provided they still meet the qualifications.

In the event that Miss Standing Rock can't fulfill her duties, the first attendant will make appearances in her place.



Miss Standing Rock Criteria

- 1. Each district of the Standing Rock Sioux reservation is eligible to enter one or more contestants in the Miss Standing Rock 2024 contest.
- 2. Miss Standing Rock contestants should appear in Indian dress, if possible or wear appropriate dress with Indian accessories, such as beaded necklaces, hair strings, etc. for interviews.
- 3. Contestants must be at least ¼ degree of Indian blood.
- 4. Contestants must be enrolled members of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe.
- 5. Contestants must be a resident living on the Standing Rock Sioux Reservation.
- 6. Contestants must be between the ages of 17 and 25 for Miss as of July 23, 2024.
- 7. Contestants must be in High School or have completed High School/GED and going on to college.
- 8. Contestant must be of high moral standards and character.
- 9. Contestants must have an interest in the advancement of the Indian people of Standing Rock.
- 10. Each contestant must be able to answer questions in the presence of judges. Questions will be prepared according.
- 11. Contestants must appear in formal dress for the luncheon to meet the judges and other contestants.
- 12. Must be able to dance Indian (Indian dancing is not considered a talent).
- 13. Contestants selected for Miss Standing Rock must not hold other titles unless approved by the organization.
- 14. Contestants must not be or ever have been married.
- 15. Contestants must not have any dependants.
- 16. Contestants should not have any dependents throughout her reign or she will be asked to forfeit the title.
- 17. Contestants must do a talent. The talent is compulsory and will affect the outcome of the contest.
- 18. Contestants competing for Miss are required to wear authentic tribal dress for the speeches and interviews.
- 19. Contestants must give a (3) minute speech on "How you would represent the Standing Rock Reservation if you were selected Miss Standing Rock".
- 20. Contestants must answer questions from a panel of (4) judges on current Indian affairs and what you know about your Sioux Culture.
- 21. Contestants must attend all annual pow-wows within the reservation and take part fully dressed with your crown and banner.
- 22. Contestants must work with all pow-wow committees at their requests.
- 23. Contestants must be available at all times for requests from districts and different organizations within the reservation.
- 24. Contestants must participate in all districts fund raising for the 2024 pow-wows, such as raffles, bingo's dinners etc.
- 25. Must be a public relations representative for the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe.
- 26. Contestants must hand in a monthly report to the coordinators for her monthly activities.
